California Dance Theatre along with their Non-Profit Performance Company, Pacific Festival Ballet, are committed to maining a positive, professional and healthy environment for all students, staff and dancers. Students are supported by a dedicated faculty as well as Artistic, and Administrative Staff.

As an integral part of CDT/PFB, students are expected to behave in a disciplined and respectful manner and to adhere to the Studio/Company's rules and regulations. Students are expected to treat Faculty, staff and other students with respect and maintain a positive attitude. The company strives to ensure that all of the rules are clear and reasonable and students are expected to observe the established Rules and Regulations. CDT/PFB reserves the right to suspend or dismiss any student who's conduct or attitude is found to be unsatisfactory. Please respect the expertise and decisions of the CDT/PFB faculty and staff.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The following rules have been put in place to ensure that the environment at CDT/PFB is safe for all students and staff and is conducive to student's learning and development. Students should abide by all the rules set forth by CDT/PFB and should maintain a professional attitude throughout the year.

CDT/PFB will maintain a warning and then dismissal policy. Any misconduct can be counted as a strike against you and an incident report will be completed for the violation and a warning will be given. A student who repeats a misconduct after the warning will be dismissed.

CDT/PFB reserves the right to dismiss students for inappropriate behavior. These issues will be dealt with on a case by case basis.

The following are prohibited at CDT/PFB:

CDT/PFB expects students to be supportive of each other and work as a team to create a positive atmosphere in the class.

Gossip, bullying or any other degrading behavior will NOT be tolerated. Students must treat their classmates, faculty with courtesy and respect. Failure to adhere to these rules may result in dismissal.
